Dance Arrival and Departure.

ANA dances are held from 6:30 pm-10:00pm. Guests are not allowed to re-enter the dance once they have left. Please make sure to have transportation plans arranged.

Dress Code

All ANA dances are school events, and the school dress code does apply. Some of these regulations are as follows.

1. Clothing should provide adequate coverage for each student.
2. No clothing that depicts discriminatory acts, violence, weapons, drugs, or alcohol is allowed

Inappropriate Dancing.

Students engaging in inappropriate dance behavior will be warned one time. After a second time, the student will be escorted to administration, and may be asked to leave the dance. Future dance privileges may be revoked at the discretion of the school administration.

1. No dancing that is sexually suggestive.
2. No dancing that staff and students find inappropriate or distasteful.

Inappropriate Behavior.

All school rules apply at dances. Students under the influence of alcohol or any other controlled substance will be denied entrance to the dance and are subject to consequences deemed appropriate by the administration. Parents will be contacted to escort the student home. If parents are unable or unwilling to escort their student home, the student will be turned over to the custody of the Carlsbad Police Department.
