

UC APPLICATION GUIDE:

1. Scroll mid-way down and click purple “**apply online**” button on right hand side.
2. Click “**create new account**”
 - Enter in your info/password and username
 - Write down your password on your manila folder
3. Start your app:
 - Which term are you applying for? → select “**Fall Quarter/Semester 2017**”
 - Are you applying as a:
 - Select “**freshman**”
 - Select “**freshman**” again with second prompt (no college)
4. Complete your address/residency/citizenship questions
5. Select all the campuses to which you would like to apply
6. Select campus majors (click on (+) mark to expand options)
 - Note: college of letters and sciences has undeclared option
 - Note: UCSD has 6 colleges and applicants must rate preference of colleges from 1-6. See counselor for comparison chart of colleges.
7. Scholarship Opportunity
 - Check all boxes that apply to you
8. Personal Info
 - Educational Opportunity Program (EOP)
 - For students with low-income families and parent’s haven’t gone to college or student has learning differences.
 - If you qualify, this could help improve your chances for college, click→ “**Yes**”
 - Parent information: report parent’s info
 - Family size and income
 - Check yes for “**claim as dependent**”
9. Academic History
 - Enter Middle School first if you took foreign language or math courses (Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II) during middle school
 - Enter ANA’s HS Code: **050470**
 - Start Date: **September 2013**
 - End Date: **June 2017**
 - Degree Diploma or certification: choose “**HS Diploma**”
 - Date to be received: **June 3, 2017**
 - High School’s Grading System: choose “**A B C D F**”
 - Check **semester (2 final grades)**
 - Click “**Add this button**” and then select (+) mark to expand and select courses taken (review your transcript)
 - Select “**Yes**” if you took courses at a junior college while in high school
 - Leave California State Student ID (CSSID) blank

10. Additional Comments:

- Type comments here to explain any academic circumstances, no test prep, moved to a different school, etc. Have counselor proofread, as colleges will compare this statement with your essay.

11. Activities and Awards

12. Test Scores

- Note: click next if test doesn't apply to you

13. Personal Insight Questions: see UC website, College Planning Guide or your counselor for insight questions

- 350 words for 4 of 8 insight questions
- 30 minute time limit, so save app and work on insight questions in word document and use single space to help with formatting
- Save doc in (txt) format
- Re-open txt document, read for accuracy and copy/paste into app.
- Additional comments essay:
 - Optional 3rd essay (550 word maximum)
 - Use to explain any information that couldn't be covered in your app/essay that is important to share
 1. Any special circumstances
 2. Moved to new school
 3. Description about life/time commitment at ANA living in a boarding school

14. Review application and print copy and have counselor review for accuracy before submitting.

- If you took SAT in October, then scores released October 30th. Wait and view scores before submitting in case you'd like to add scores.
- App fee for domestic students: \$70 per campus application
- App fee for international students : \$80 per campus application
