



The Army and Navy Academy Health Center

Dear Parents,

We are very pleased that your Camper/Cadet is going to attend the Army and Navy Academy Summer Programs. Please read the instructions carefully as any errors can cause delay on registration day.

To begin the health process for your Camper/Cadet to attend the summer camp, please log on to: <https://anasummer.campbrainregistration.com/>.

All forms must be completed no later than, June 15th. If forms are not complete by the registration deadline, please expect a delay in your registration process.

Requirements prior to arrival:

- **Camp Brain:** There are a series of medical questions that will need to be answered, along with the insurance information, medical doctor information and most importantly the EMERGENCY CONTACTS information.
- **Asthma:** You will need to answer Yes or No. If yes- please explain in detail.
- **Allergies:** Clearly state **ALL** allergies; environmental and medicinal. Please clarify if your Cadet/Camper requires an Epi-pen for severe allergies (An Epi-Pen must be made available to the Health Center on behalf of your Camper/Cadet and another for the Camper/Cadet to carry on his/her person at **ALL** times).
- **Consent to Treat:** Giving us permission to treat your Cadet/Camper. (Signature Required) Your Cadet/Camper can NOT be given any medical treatment without this signature. We cannot administer something as little as Tylenol.
- **Medical and Therapeutic Compliance:** Initials and signature of Camper/Cadet and parents/guardian will be required for this section. This form shows that you and your Cadet/Camper acknowledge and understand the workings of our Health Center.
- **Physical Examination:** a physical is needed prior to his/her arrival. He/She will need to have a sports clearance and the form must be filled out by a physician with the office stamp.
- **Immunizations:** Camper/Cadet must be up-to-date on ALL his/her shots. If your camper/cadet is not fully immunized this will hinder his/her ability to attend camp. ALL campers/cadets will require a recent TB test in order to attend camp international and domestic. **This is a requirement** no exceptions will be made.
- **Insurance:** A copy of the front and back of the insurance card will be needed. If you are purchasing the insurance from the Academy (international students only) please disregard this section and the Health Center will upload the card for you once received.

- **Medication Authorization Form:** If your Camper/Cadet is taking any form of medication: prescription, Over the Counter, or a Vitamin Supplement that you want him/her to take; **the physician must sign this form. All medications must be administered through the Health Center. No herbs or supplements are allowed in the cadets'/campers rooms. We are unable to accept foreign medication or supplements. Please note that MEDICATIONS FROM OTHER COUNTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED DUE TO FDA AND FEDERAL LAW.**
- **TB (Tuberculin Clearance), CBC (Complete Blood Count), UA (Urine Analysis):** This is a requirement for any summer Cadets/Campers that have the intention of attending the Academy in the **Fall**, it is a requirement for ALL first year students international and domestic. Your physician can complete this process. **Please have ALL results attached with the paperwork a notation of WNL will not be accepted.**
- ***** TB (Tuberculin Clearance):** Required for all Campers living outside of the U.S. for more than 28 consecutive days.

All the forms can be located on Camp Brain, except the electronic portion and must be completed by parent(s), **legal** guardian (legal documentation required) or the physician. The completion of these forms **must be in English.** A host family or agent may not fill out this information upon the time of arrival; for health and safety reasons, these are legally binding documents requiring the legal parent(s) or legal guardian must complete.
